The TIC Scholarship aims to support and encourage diverse candidates to pursue a career in the property and casualty insurance industry. This scholarship offers financial assistance in the form of up to four (4) \$3,500 scholarships to applicants with a demonstrated intention to build their careers in this field. Selection is focused on commitment to enter the insurance industry, financial need and contribution to school and/or community life. Academic excellence is not a primary consideration.

Scholarship Amount
Up to a total of four (4) scholarships annually
at a value of \$3,500 each

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, an applicant must:

1. demonstrate a clear intention to build a career in property & casualty insurance (see Personal Statement requirement);
2. demonstrate financial need (see Personal Statement requirement);
3. be registered in a recognized college or university undergraduate degree program in Canada, or pursuing the Canadian Accredited Insurance Broker (CAIB) designation, The Chartered Insurance Professional (CIP®) designation, the Insurance Brokers Association Ontario licensing preparation course, or the Risk Management Certificate;
4. be a permanent resident of Canada.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Past scholarship recipients cannot apply again.
- Applicants must submit their own applications and references must be submitted by the referees directly.
- Preference will be given to applicants from Black, Indigenous, people of color (BIPOC), 2SLGBTQIA+, people with disabilities, or other historically underrepresented groups. Preference will also be given to Ontario residents.
- Applicants may be interviewed (virtually or in person as appropriate).
- Candidates selected for an interview will be contacted by April 30, 2026.
